- If the Dining Hall is reserved for a large event (such as a wedding), the Lakeside Cabin will not be rented to a third party in order to avoid interference with other renters.
- For events such as weddings, the Dining Hall may be rented for a 12-hr period for the main event, and then for a 4-hr period prior to and/or subsequent to for setup or cleanup. [Example: Non Resident Wedding rental for 4-hours on Friday for set up - \$250. A 12-hr rental for the wedding on Saturday - \$650. Plus a 4-hr rental on Sunday for clean up - \$250. Total = \$1,150]
- Rentals with a long lead time must have a completed and signed Rental Agreement, check for security deposit, check for total fees (prepaid), and an Insurance Certificate in place, no later than 45 days before the event in order to hold the date.
- Make checks payable to “Town of Woodstock”. Include the Date of the Event on the check’s memo line.
